## SIGNIFICANCE

In the seal's center is a shield representing the protection that cybersecurity provides from malicious threats. It is blue to show our loyalty and commitment to advancing the cybersecurity field. Within the shield stands three resolute embattlements signifying our three-pronged mission: developing cyber leaders in the classroom, shaping cyber education in the academy, and promoting cyber awareness in society. Looking through the portholes, the redoubts envision us living out the clarity, conviction, and character that arise from our Christian faith and values. The prominent turret combines character, the trait all excellent cyberspace operators possess, with our most important mission, developing cyber leaders. While tempered blue, the towers are shadowed red acknowledging our pursuit of mastery in both defensive and offensive cyber operations. Lastly, the background lines form three quasi-crosses, paying homage to the three background crosses in the Cedarville University emblem. Inscribed near the shield's base is Proverbs 22:29, which reminds us that diligence and skillfulness are the traits that allow all to honorably serve their leaders and ultimately the King of kings. Flanking the shield on both sides are wheat stalks symbolizing our alma mater in the cornfields of Cedarville, Ohio where great pioneers like the Wright Brothers have gone before us and where current technological breakthroughs are happening at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, our region's cyber hub. The top scroll reads our name while the bottom scroll bears our university. The stars between the plaintexts resemble the National Security Agency's seal, the premier cyber organization in the world, and highlight our partnership with them as a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Operations and Cyber Defense. The seal's outer edge is subdued yellow signifying our joyful yet humble attitude amidst the technical complexity of cyberspace.
