According to the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), the shortage of cybersecurity professionals is estimated to be 2.72 million globally. In 2022, there were about 590,000 cybersecurity job openings in the United States alone, and the demand for cyber experts will only increase. In Ohio, the average annual salary for cybersecurity jobs in general is over \$100,000. Now is a better time than ever before to start preparing for a high demand, high paying cyber career.
